

## Wendy A. Lawrence-Fowler, Ph.D.

Dr. Wendy A. Lawrence-Fowler serves The University of Texas-Pan American as the Vice Provost for Research and Sponsored Projects and is a professor in the Department of Computer Science. Previously she served as the founding Director of UTPA's Center for Distance Learning and Teaching Excellence. Under her leadership at UTPA, the research expenditures have tripled, and developed the infrastructure for technology transfer.

Before joining the faculty at UTPA in 1990 she designed software for the National Service Division at IBM- Austin, was a research associate at the New Mexico State University Computing Research Laboratory, a Research Scientist at the New Mexico State University Primate Research Institute, and a visiting scientist at Southwest Foundation for Biomedical Research.

After attending the University of Colorado and the University of Minnesota, Dr. Lawrence-Fowler received her BS in Zoology from The Ohio State University. She earned an MA in Anthropology and her PhD in Biological Anthropology from The Ohio State University. After a post-doc, she earned an MS in Computer Science from New Mexico State University.
